

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE RECALL PETITION

TO THE HONORABLE ARNOLD SCHWARZENEGGER: Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned registered qualified voters of the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of Governor, in the State of California, and to demand election of a successor in that office.

The grounds for the recall are as follows:

WE NEED A REAL GOVERNOR, NOT A STAND-IN. Although actors are valuable assets in Hollywood, in Sacramento we need someone who truly wants to invest in California, not destroy it. Throughout California's great history, our state's leaders, Republican and Democratic alike, understood that allowing corporations to escape paying their fair share of taxes—taxes vital to the continued investment in the California Dream—is simply UNPATRIOTIC. We need a Governor who believes in educating our children, in providing reliable public services, and whose word can be trusted. You promised to “reform government” but instead launched an unprecedented attack on teachers, nurses, police officers, and firefighters. By promising to “tear-up the credit card,” but instead forcing the State to go further into debt, by promising not to raise taxes, but instead raising student fees on those who can least afford it, by promising schools their fair share of state revenue, but instead cutting their budgets, and by promising not to cater to “special interests,” but instead raising more money from special interests in one year than your predecessor did in four years in office, the people of the Great State of California have **LOST THEIR TRUST IN YOU.**
