

# Get help applying for assistance



San Diego Gas and Electric®, the San Diego Housing Commission (SDHC), and San Diego and Imperial Counties Labor Council and its member unions have come together for a one-night event to sign you up for the assistance you may need.

**WHEN:** Friday May 28, 2021 from 5 p.m - 7:30 p.m.

**WHERE:** 4265 Fairmount Ave., San Diego, CA 92105 (walk-ups welcome and encouraged due to limited parking onsite)

**WHY:** Helping San Diego families apply for help paying past-due rent and utility bills

We will provide on-site assistance with your application if you do not have access to a computer or the internet or may just need help on the application process.

City of San Diego residents experiencing financial hardship because of the COVID-19 pandemic may qualify for help from the City of San Diego's COVID-19 Housing Stability Assistance Program, which SDHC administers. This program will help qualifying households pay past-due, unpaid rent and utilities. If funds remain available after past-due, unpaid rent payments have been made for qualifying households, the program can pay up to 25 percent of the tenant's upcoming monthly rent for April 2021 through June 2021. The program also can help pay past-due internet service expenses. **Per guidance from the U.S. Department of Treasury, the financial help this program provides to a household is not considered income for the household. The program does not ask about immigration status; it does not affect eligibility for the program.**

## If able, please bring the following information:

- Rental document such as a lease, rent ledger, letter, or other
- Past-due rent notice, rent ledger, letter, or other
- Current utility/household bill
- Gross annual household income for the calendar year 2020
- Current household income
